Burien Arts is seeking a dedicated volunteer to curate and manage our gallery wall programming at the Burien Community Center. Estimated time commitment: 4-8 hours per quarter. Key qualifications and responsibilities include:

Required Qualifications:

- Knowledge or interest in contemporary visual art forms, emerging artists, and curatorial practices
- Project management and event coordination experience
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Familiarity with nonprofit operations and community arts programming
- Flexibility and ability to work collaboratively with volunteers, artists, venue contact, and board members
- Submit a short monthly report to the board that should include:
 - Any needs/request/suggestions
 - Highlight any accomplishment (reception dates, artist being shown etc)

This is a volunteer position that would work closely with the Board of Directors and could lead to a recommendation for a board position at the end of one year.

- Duration: 3–4 months per exhibition (quarterly)
- Artist Reception: 5:00–6:30pm with light refreshments once per exhibition
